For all Homecoming dress down days, the following dress code applies:

- Tops must have sleeves/straps at least four fingers wide and a neckline that touches the collar bone.
- T-shirts without a collar are allowed.
- Shirts cannot include written sayings or be political in nature.
- No athletic shorts or sweatpants unless they coordinate with the designated theme for the day.
- No leggings or spandex.
- Dresses/skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- Uniform shoes are not required, however shoes should be appropriate for recess and PE. Shoes should be close toed and have a back. No flip flips, crocs or boots.
- Students may wear jeans, provided they coordinate with the designated theme for the day. Jeans should not have rips or holes.
- Face paint, hair paint or props are not allowed. No glitter.

Dressing up during Homecoming Week is optional. Students who chose to not dress up should be in uniform.
