Graduation Requirements

- English 4 Credits
- Mathematics 4 Credits
 - o Algebra 1, Geometry, Math, Math
- Science 3 Credits
 - Biology, Science, Science
- History 4 Credits
 - World History, American History, US Government (.5 credits)
 and Economics (.5 credits)
- World Language 2 Credits



Graduation Requirements

- PFA (Performing, Practical or Fine Art) 1 Credits
- Health and Physical Education 1 Credit
- Personal Financial Literacy 1 Credit
- Electives 5.5 Credits
- At least one course within the 24 credits must be completed online
- Must have at least a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Must pass reading assessment, math assessment, F.A.S.T Grade 10 Reading and Algebra 1 EOC



Designations for Bright Futures Scholarship

Florida Academic Scholar

- 3.5 GPA
- 1330 SAT
- 29 ACT
- 100 Service Hours

- Covers 100% tuition and eligible fees
- Private Institutions award a dollar amount per credit hour
- Automatically renews, students must maintain an unweighted GPA of 3.0



Designations for Bright Futures Scholarship

Florida Medallion Scholar

- 3.0 GPA
- 1210 SAT
- 25 ACT
- 75 Service Hours

- Covers 75% tuition and eligible fees
- Private Institutions award a dollar amount per credit hour
- Automatically renews, students must maintain an unweighted GPA of 2.75



Accelerated Course Offerings

Bright Futures calculates GPA only for the 16-18 eligible credits on a student's transcript.

- English 4 Credits
- Mathematics 4 Credits
- Science 3 Credits
- History 3 Credits
- World Language 2 Credits (in the same language)
- Additional Eligible Credits 2



Accelerated Course Offerings

- Advanced Placement
- Honors
- Dual Enrollment



Accelerated Course Offerings

Advanced Placement

- Student can earn college credit
- Standardized Test, written by College Board
- Nor required to submit test scores on college app
- Colleges will award credit differently
- Contributes to a student's weighted
 GPA

Dual Enrollment

- Student will earn college credit
- Typically adds less competitive edge compared to AP
- Will be required to submit transcript with college application
- Out of state colleges may honor credit differently
- Contributes to a student's weighted
 GPA
