Soccer Club (K-2nd) with Soccer Shots | \$228 for 12 weeks (can be paid monthly)

Soccer Shots is an introductory Soccer program where we introduce the game of soccer to children through an enthusiastic and engaging curriculum.

TUESDAY

Little Miss Manners (1st-3rd) with Mrs. Cottle | \$150 for 12 weeks (can be paid in one or two installments)

In Little Miss Manners Club, young ladies will learn timeless social skills through engaging, hands-on activities inspired by traditional cotillion classes. Members will practice proper introductions, conversation skills, table manners, thank-you note writing, hosting and guest etiquette, and other essential social courtesies. Through games, role-playing, crafts, and special events, girls will build confidence, character, kindness, and poise while developing meaningful friendships in a fun and supportive environment.

Coding Club (K-5th) with WIZE Computing Academy | \$360 for 12 weeks (can be paid monthly)

Students will develop foundational and advanced STEM skills through engaging, hands-on activities. They begin with LEGO Robotics and MIT Scratch/Scratch Jr. to learn the fundamentals of coding, problem-solving, and computational thinking. As they progress, students explore Minecraft Education, Scrib3D Pen, micro, and other innovative programs that build skills in programming, robotics, engineering, creativity, and digital design while fostering collaboration, critical thinking, and real-world problem-solving. Students will build foundational coding and technology skills through fun, hands-on projects using MIT Scratch and Scratch Jr. Grouped by age, students learn at their level through age-appropriate coding challenges, games, animations, and creative projects. Learners may also explore LEGO Robotics, Minecraft, and other technology platforms while strengthening problem-solving, creativity, teamwork, perseverance, and confidence.

Parents will receive ClassDojo updates throughout the club, and students will wrap up the program with a fun Carnival Day featuring unplugged activities and prizes earned with class points.
